



One of the greatest difficulties our organization faces is the challenge of trying to accommodate the hunting test needs of our membership. Our judging resources and test site locations are limited. In order to try to be more responsive to the needs of our membership, we would ask that you respond to the questions which follow. For those who are new to our organization, a brief explanation of our tests may be in order.

The Breed Tests, VJP and HZP, are open to pups born the previous year or the last three months of the year before that. The VJP is the Spring Puppy Test. In it, pups are evaluated on Tracking (live rabbits/hares, Nose, Search, and Pointing (no strict obedience, no water work, no retrieves). The HZP, or Fall Breed Test, requires absolute retrieving reliability on land and water, a moderately high level of obedience (sit and hold to delivery, and skilled performance in pointing, nose, and search. Please indicate, in the spaces provided, the number of dogs you are likely to want to enter in each of the types of tests during the calendar year for which you are joining :
